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CONFIDENTIAL CIRCULAR REGARDING LEAVE TRAINS IN FRANCE.

[PUBLISHED WITH G.R.O. 4345.]

With reference to Confidential Circular S.S. 718 issued with G.R.O. 4305, dated 19-6-18.

Officers and O.R.s proceeding on leave to Paris will travel to Rouen under arrangements made by Armies, and will be collected there in time to catch Special Trains, which will run from Rouen to Paris on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays in each week. All ranks proceeding to Paris on leave must go and return by these trains.

Trains will run from Paris to Rouen on the same days.

Probable timings as follows:—

Rouen (Rive Gauche)...	Dep. 6.08.
Paris (Gare St. Lazaire)	Arr. 12.39.
Paris (Gare St. Lazaire)	Dep. 14.13.
Rouen (Rive Gauche)	Arr. 19.16.

No tickets will be required on these Special Trains. There will be no intermediate booked stops. First train, from Rouen to Paris, is being arranged for 24th instant.

Train Services from various Army Areas to Rouen are attached. In order to catch the above-mentioned Special Trains from Rouen to Paris, Officers and O.R.s should leave Railheads as under:—

From First Army.	On the day before Special Train leaves Rouen.
From Second Army.	Ditto.
From Fourth Army.	Ditto.
From Fifth Army.	Ditto.
From Third Army.	Two days before Special Train leaves Rouen.

For the return journey men will go into the reinforcement camp at Rouen and be forwarded by reinforcement trains.
