







## TAPE RELEASE FOR MAGAZINE CATCH.

A simple device for facilitating the removal of a magazine from the Lewis Gun may be made from an ordinary piece of tape, balf an inch wide, or from the string of an old puttee. The method of making and using it is shown in the drawing below.





By simply pulling the loop that lies upon the top of the magazine, the magazine can be lifted off with one hand.

SEWING.

While this is not recommended as the normal practice, owing to the rapidity with which the tape will wear through, it is considered that the attachment may prove very useful in positions where there is no room for No. 2 to take his normal place beside the gun, or where, for any other reason, there is a chance of the firer being left alone. In firing from the hip it makes the change of magazines much more easy.
